

**PUBLIC HEARING
FEBRUARY 16, 2016**

A Public Hearing was held at 5:15 p.m., Tuesday, February 16, 2016, in the Council Chamber of the City Office Building, 214 North Lafayette, Marshall, Missouri, with the following members of the City Council present: Mayor Pro Tem Dan Brandt; Council Members Barbara Utlaut, Sheila Cook, Vince Lutterbie, Gabe Ramsey, Charles Guthrey and Ron Duvall; City Administrator Connie Latimer; City Counselor Josh Taylor and City Clerk Janet French. Mayor Mark Gooden and Council Member Tom Hagedorn absent.
