

ORDINANCE NO. 8305

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, MISSOURI, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SALINE COUNTY, MISSOURI, AND THE SALINE COUNTY COLLECTOR FOR THE COLLECTION OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES LEVIED BY THE CITY OF MARSHALL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marshall (the "City") levies taxes on real and personal property located in Saline County, Missouri and has a need to have said taxes collected;

**WHEREAS**, the City, Saline County, Missouri, and the Office of the Saline County Collector are authorized to enter into cooperative agreements for tax collection purposes;

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Saline County Collector (the "Collector"), with the approval of the Saline County Commission and pursuant to a written agreement with the City, currently collect said taxes and maintain records regarding said tax collection on behalf of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Saline County Collector and County wish to update the prior agreement with the City.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Marshall, Missouri, as follows:


**Section 1.** The Mayor of the City of Marshall, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Saline County, Missouri, and the Office of the Saline County Collector that authorizes the Collector to collect taxes levied by the City on real and personal property and remit the collected sums to the City. Pursuant to said agreement, the City will pay to the Office of the Saline County Collector as and for compensation for the services rendered under said agreement:

- a. One percent (1%) of the total amount of taxes collected on behalf of the City by the Collector;
- b. One percent (1.0%) of all taxes collected by the Collector, including those of other Saline County political subdivisions, up to Seventy-five Thousand and 00/100ths Dollars (\$75,000.00); and
- c. One-half of one percent (0.5%) of taxes collected on behalf of the City as a fee for the mailing of statements and receipts.

**Section 2.** The initial term of the agreement shall end on February 28, 2017, subject to an automatic renewal provision that will renew the agreement for successive one-year terms.

**Section 3.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and approval.
