



Entry-Level Officer

The Marshall Police Department is seeking qualified applicants to fill an entry-level Police Officer position.

Minimum Qualifications:

- At least 21 years of age
- High School Diploma, GED, or HiSet
- Vision correctable to 20/20 in each eye
- Ability to pass a written and physical test
- Be of good character (background investigation required prior to employment)
- Willing to attend a regional law enforcement academy.

Applicants who meet the minimum qualifications but have yet to attend a law enforcement academy are encouraged to apply. The City of Marshall will sponsor the successful candidate to attend an academy and bring them on as an entry-level officer.

Applicants who already have a P.O.S.T. license and are currently working or have worked as a Peace Officer will be eligible for a \$4,500.00 signing incentive.

Duties: Uniform patrol, traffic enforcement, community-oriented policing. Other duties as assigned.

Salary: Starting salary is \$43,035.00 (annually) with normal increases to \$44,928.00, for promotion to a second-class officer within 6 months and \$46,883.00 within one year of hire with promotion to a first-class officer.

Benefits: Benefits include health, dental, vision, retirement, vacation, overtime, holidays, sick days, and longevity pay. The Marshall Police Department supplies uniforms, leather gear, and bullet-resistant vests.
